- Section B:** This section is the central part of the map, showing the Nagaoka River flowing through the town of Kyotanabe. Key features include 玉水橋 (Tama-no-mizu Bridge), 泉ヶ丘中学校 (Suikei-ko Junior High School), 井手小学校 (Imado Elementary School), 正蓮寺 (Seiryūji Temple), 阿弥陀寺 (Amida-ji Temple), and 天神川 (Tenjin-gawa).
