




# New System and Fee for Disposing Household Waste Starting from October 1, 2018



In an effort to promote waste reduction and recycling, and to leave a rich, natural environment for the next generation, Kizugawa City will be implementing a new system and fee for disposing waste using designated trash bags sold in stores throughout the city.

This notice contains information on how to take out your garbage with the new system.

## ○ What is "new" about the new household waste collection system?

Starting October 1, 2018, the waste category "combustible waste" will be redefined to include both combustible waste and non-recyclable plastic and vinyl goods. Waste from this new category must be disposed of in "designated trash bags" purchased at participating stores.
