DISTRACTED CYCLING

Cyclists who cause a **traffic hazard**

Face up to **1 year** in prison or a fine up to **¥300,000**

Cyclists who **talk into mobile devices** or **look at them** while moving

Face up to **6 months** in prison or a fine up to **¥100,000**

Dangerous situations while cycling

- Jump the red light • “No entry” violation
- Do not slow down when passing a pedestrian road
- Cycle on the wrong side of the road • Lane violation
- Enter a railroad crossing • Violate the intersection safety rules
- Obstruct priority vehicles at an intersection
- Violate the roundabout safety rules
- Ignore the stop sign
- Violate traffic rules when passing a pedestrian road
- Ride a bike with damaged brakes
- Cycle under the influence of alcohol (**drunk cycling**)
- Violate the safety cycling rules • Cycle recklessly
